



Information on the processing of personal data

§ 1 Data controller

The administrator of your data processed as part of a neuroinformatics hackathon entitled: "Brainhack Warsaw 2027" is the University of Warsaw, ul. Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, 00-927 Warsaw.

§ 2 Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer, whom you can contact by e-mail at the following address: iod@adm.uw.edu.pl.

You can contact the DPO in all matters relating to the processing of your personal data by the University of Warsaw and the exercise of your rights related to the processing of personal data.

The tasks of the DPO do not, however, cover other matters, such as providing information on the conference.

§ 3 Purposes and legal grounds for processing

Personal data will be processed for the purpose of :

- Your registration, and participation in the neuroinformatics hackathon entitled "Brainhack Warsaw 2027",
- Networking, including sharing your CV with Event sponsors, where you have provided the necessary consent.

The basis for the processing of personal data marked in the registration form as “required data” is Article 6(1)(b) GDPR, as such data is necessary for the performance of the agreement concerning participation in the Event. Personal data may also be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) GDPR where processing is necessary to fulfil a legal obligation to which the

Administrator is subject, including obligations arising from tax and accounting regulations. Personal data provided for the purpose of networking, including sharing a CV with Event sponsors, will be processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) GDPR, where the participant has given consent. Providing such data is voluntary and is not required to participate in the Event.

§ 4 Data storage period

Your personal data will be processed for the duration of the hackathon, and then for the period required by tax and accounting regulations. **After this time, the data will be deleted.** (robimy to?)

§ 5 Data recipients

Access to your personal data will be granted to authorized employees, associates or students of the University of Warsaw who must process your data in connection with the hackathon.

Personal data may be disclosed to public authorities, institutions or third parties authorized to request access or receive personal data on the basis of applicable law.

§ 6 Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Registration for the event takes place using forms and drives provided by Google. Your data will be processed by our provider of the G-Suit service for education, Google (with whom we have signed a contract for entrusting the processing of personal data) in its data processing centers [\[1\]](#).

§ 7 Data processing rights

We guarantee you the implementation of all your rights under the terms of the GDPR, i.e. the right to:

- access to data and receipt of a copy thereof;
- rectify (correct) your personal data;
- restrictions on the processing of personal data;
- deletion of personal data (subject to Article 17 (3) of the GDPR);
- file a complaint to the President of the Data Protection Office, if you believe that the processing of personal data violates the law on the protection of personal data.

§ 8 Obligation to provide data and the consequence of failure to provide data

Providing data marked as "required" is obligatory. If you do not provide your data, you will not be able to participate in the conference. Providing other data specified in the form is not necessary to participate in the conference.

In addition, we would like to inform you that photos will be taken during the conference, which will then be published on the websites and social media belonging to the University of Warsaw.
